1. Winter Readiness and Tier 3 Screeners

- Winter screeners will become available to use on November 1.
- To assign a winter screener and make it available, each educator will need to
 - Click on the **Active Course** they would like to screen.
 - **SUBSCRIBE** their active courses to **Delta Math – Winter** under the **AVAILABLE PROGRAMS**.
 - Use the drop down for Select Program to choose **Winter**.
 - Click **Assign & View**, then make it **Available**.

2. Updated Screening Cycle Start Dates

- As new screening cycles begin, screeners from previous cycles will continue to be accessible
 - Fall begins August 15
 - Fall Progress begins October 1
 - Winter begins November 1
 - Winter Progress begins December 1
 - Spring begins March 1
 - Spring Progress begins April 1.
- Below is one recommended screening schedule for a multi-tiered system of support.
 - Tier 2 identification and support:
 - September: Fall Readiness - to identify unfinished learning.
 - November: Fall Progress - to monitor and adjust. (Optional)
 - January: Winter Readiness - to measure growth.
 - Tier 1 identification and support:
 - February: Winter Readiness for the next grade level)
 - April: Winter Progress for the next grade level. (Optional)
 - May: Spring Readiness for the next grade level.

3. Celebrate Student Success!

- The [Winter Data Review](#) includes protocols for generating winter data on the **REPORTS tab** of the [screening and reporting website](#) to make instructional decisions. **Protocol #2** includes the celebration of completed learning with your team and your staff. Don't forget to celebrate with your students and parents, too!
