

Good Afternoon,

Please share these updates with your staff to support their implementation of the Delta Math RtI Program.

1. Spring Screening Cycle

- The spring screening cycle begins on March 1. All fall and winter screeners will continue to be available through June 14.
- To assign spring screeners and make them available, follow the steps outlined below.
 - Click on the **Active Course** you would like to screen.
 - **SUBSCRIBE** the active courses to **Delta Math - Spring** under the **AVAILABLE PROGRAMS**.
 - Use the drop down for **Select Program** to choose **Delta Math - Spring**.
 - Click **Assign & View**, then click to make it **Available**.

2. Summer School and 2022-23 Data Availability

- Summer school enrollments will begin on June 15, the beginning of the 2023-24 school year for online accounts. If you would like to use Delta Math's online readiness screeners for summer programs, please complete the form "Register for Summer School" on the [Contact Us](#) implementation support page.
- On June 14, we will save student results from the 2022/2023 school year. Then, we will remove all 2022/23 enrollments and student data from the screening and reporting platform. On June 15, the screening and reporting site will be ready for enrollments and student screening for the 2023/2024 school year. School district technology representatives will then be able to enroll students and educators in courses as schedules become available in their district student information system.
- Student results from the 2022/2023 school year will be available after June 14 in the "[Additional Reports](#)" linked near the bottom of the page at www.deltamath.org. Each district is assigned a common username and password to access student results from prior years. To request your district's username and password, complete the form "Help Desk for Current Participants" on the [Contact Us](#) implementation support page.

3. Secondary Math Geometry

- Due to increased requests for geometry readiness screeners to support the MMC graduation requirements, work has begun to develop middle school and high school geometry readiness screeners.
- The primary source used to identify each high priority geometry standard was the [Geometry Progressions document](#). This document identifies key connections among standards and important pedagogical choices to be made.
- The [Delta Math Geometry Readiness Standards](#) target assessable components of each high priority standard and will be used to guide the development of future Delta Math assessment tools.
- Geometry readiness screeners are scheduled to be available by August 15, 2023. The development of quick checks, growth charts, and visual guided practice is scheduled throughout the 2023-24 school year.
