In the Career Learning Center (CLC) program, our goal is to support students who want to explore different career pathways of interest through involvement in a variety of ways, including industry tours, project-based learning in a lab setting, and career exploration through work-based learning experiences. CLC supports students in taking advantage of all the ways students can further explore their skills and interests in order to find a career path that's a good fit for their future.

While in CLC, students will have an opportunity to:

- Experience industry tours to area businesses.
- Learn and build upon career readiness skills, through classroom activities, experiences and reflection.
- Have hands-on experiences in a lab setting exploring basic skills of different career paths.
- Have the opportunity to participate in job shadows and work-based learning opportunities.
- Learn about financial planning through various financial literacy simulations and guest speakers.
- Develop a plan to achieve future career opportunities and career goals.

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Course Outline:

CLC instructors will guide students through the exploration of many different career pathways. Each pathway will be examined through labs, tours, professional networking, job shadows, work-based learning and guest speakers. Students will work on basic skills, growing their social capital, employability skills, and financial literacy.

Pathways Explored:

- Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources
- Arts & Communication
- Business, Management, Marketing & Technology
- Construction, Electrical & Plumbing
- Engineering/Manufacturing/Welding
- Health Care
- Human Services & Culinary
- Transportation/Basic Car Maintenance

Work-Based Learning: All students at CTC have the opportunity to participate in experiences (such as guest speakers, tours, and work experiences) that connect them with local employers in their program area.

Safety Training Provided In: CPR/AED Tool safety for lab, and OSHA 10-Hour General Industry.

Student Leadership Opportunities: Students have the opportunity to engage in activities to develop relationships with classmates and community partners to strengthen their leadership skills.
